Middle Tennessee State University has graduated 128,503 students since its inception in 1911. These students have received associate, bachelor's, master's, educational specialist, and doctoral degrees. Our first Doctor of Arts degrees were conferred on December 22, 1972, the first Educational Specialist degrees on December 20, 1974, and the first Doctor of Philosophy on May 10, 2003. There have been 399 Doctor of Arts degrees, 1,796 Educational Specialist degrees, and 196 Doctor of Philosophy degrees awarded.

Carroll Van West 2015 Career Achievement Award Recipient



Dr. Carroll Van West, a professor in MTSU's History Department since 1985, teaches courses in architectural history, historic preservation, and state and local history.

He is the state historian of Tennessee, named to the post by Gov. Bill Haslam in 2013. He is also co-chair of the Tennessee Civil War Sesquicentennial Commission and director of the Tennessee Civil War National Heritage Area.

West holds a B.A. from MTSU, a master's degree in History from the University of Tennessee, and a Ph.D. in History from the College of William and Mary.

He has directed to completion approximately 100 master's theses as well as 14 doctoral dissertations by MTSU graduate students.

His research interests lie in 19th- and 20th-century Southern and Western history as well as architecture and material culture.

West has directed hundreds of historic preservation projects across Tennessee, and he has worked with museum and preservation projects in many other states. Most recently, he has been working on historic preservation issues in Alabama and Montana. West has written numerous articles, chapters, and book reviews in Southern and Western history. His blog documents and interprets 30 years of preservation work in the state of Montana.

He has been a referee for multiple National Endowment for the Humanities (NEH) review panels and served on NEH projects in Tennessee and Montana. West is on the board of advisors for the National Trust for Historic Preservation, the Lewis and Clark Trust, and the Teaching with Primary Sources program of the Library of Congress. He works extensively with the National Register of Historic Places on documentation projects, and his past works range from the Sullivan Jackson house in Selma, Alabama, to the Grand Ole Opry House in Nashville, to the Historic Farms in Tennessee 1780–1955 project.

West's passion for his discipline is affirmed by sustained commitment to excellence and an incredible body of work in the field of history. His outstanding career, devoted to the power of living stories—past and present—also speaks to his commitment to community-building through the celebration of heritage.

Stewardship, shared identity, purpose, and community are not only the hallmarks of his work in Tennessee but also across the South and into the far West.

Megan Barry
Mayor, Metropolitan Nashville and Davidson County



Mayor Megan Barry is the seventh mayor of Metropolitan Nashville and Davidson County following a historic election in which she became the first woman and first member of the Metro Council to be elected Mayor.

Barry won the runoff September 10, 2015, after receiving the most votes in the August 6 general election.

She moved to Nashville in 1991 to earn her M.B.A. at Vanderbilt University after receiving her bachelor's degree in elementary education from Baker University in Kansas. Barry then built a 20-year career as an ethics compliance officer and consultant in the telecommunications and health care sectors.

First elected in the runoff election of 2007 for an at-large Metro Council seat, Barry went on to receive the most votes of the five winning at-large candidates in 2011.

As Nashville mayor, she plans to focus on improving the educational outcomes of the city's public schools; engaging regional and state partners to develop a unified vision and plan for transportation; creating more affordable housing options for residents of all backgrounds; and continuing to build the economy while ensuring all parts of Davidson County share in the prosperity.

Barry has also put a renewed emphasis on supporting the music industry and the city's creative and entrepreneurial sectors.

In December of 2015, Barry convened the first of multiple youth violence summits aimed at bringing the community together to discuss and address issues related to the rise in violence among teenagers and young adults in Nashville.

In building her administration, the new mayor has put a sharp focus on ensuring that the Mayor's Office is reflective of the city it serves. To that end, Barry has put together the most diverse team in the history of Metro Nashville, with a majority female staff and African-Americans, Latinos, and LGBT Nashvillians in key leadership positions throughout the administration.

Barry is married to Bruce Barry, a professor of Organization Studies at Vanderbilt. Their son, Max, is a junior in college, and they share their home with two rescue dogs, Hank and Boris.

Kary Antholis

President, HBO Miniseries and Cinemax Programming, Home Box Office



Kary Antholis is responsible for overseeing the development and production of HBO Miniseries and Cinemax original programming as a division president for Home Box Office.

Antholis is currently serving as program executive for HBO's adaptation of the BBC original miniseries *Criminal Justice*; the upcoming six-part miniseries event *American Lion* starring Sean Penn; and the forthcoming Cinemax program *Outcast*, from *The Walking Dead* creator Robert Kirkman. For Cinemax, Antholis also supervises the development and production of *Strike Back*, *Banshee*, and the original series *The Knick* from director Steven Soderbergh and starring Clive Owen.

Most recently, Antholis was program executive on the six-part miniseries *Show Me A Hero*, as well as the multiple Emmy-winning four-part miniseries event *Olive Kitteridge*, adapted from the Pulitzer Prize-winning novel and starring Frances McDormand.

He previously oversaw the adaptation of J.K. Rowling's bestselling novel *The Casual Vacancy* while supervising the development of the Golden Globe and multiple Emmy-winning miniseries *Mildred Pierce*, starring Kate Winslet; the multiple Emmy-winning miniseries *John Adams* and *Generation Kill*; and the epic 10-part World War II event *The Pacific*.

Antholis first joined HBO in 1992 as director of documentary programming, where he oversaw the development and production of award-winning documentaries such as *Educating Peter*, *The Broadcast Tapes of Dr. Peter*, and *Gang War: Bangin' in Little Rock*. He left HBO in 1994 to produce and direct the documentary *One Survivor Remembers*, which debuted on HBO and won an Oscar and a Primetime Emmy. *One Survivor Remembers* was added to the National Film Registry by the Librarian of Congress, an honor given to "culturally, historically or aesthetically" significant American films. Antholis rejoined HBO in April 1997 and later became senior vice president of HBO Films & Miniseries, serving as program executive for the multiple Emmy-winning miniseries *Angels in America*, among others.

He started his television career with ZM Productions in 1990. Previously, Antholis practiced law and taught history. He holds a B.A. in History and French Literature from Bowdoin College, an M.A. in European History from Stanford University, and a J.D. from Georgetown University.

Mace and Chain of Office

Originally a medieval knight's weapon, the mace evolved into a symbol of royal scepters in various crown jewel collections. Large versions of the scepter have come to represent the power and authority of institutions such as our University. The mace measures 50 inches in length and is made of Tennessee cherry wood embellished with solid sterling silver and lapis lazuli. The Tennessee flower, the iris, denotes the public the University serves who, by their loyalty, give it strength and power. The leaves form a crown to symbolize the ennobling achievements of our graduates. Tennessee freshwater pearls, the official state gem, suggest the inestimable value of inquiring young minds. The streamer on the wood shaft carries the names by which the University has been known since its founding. The finial at the base of the mace is a stylized nut, representing the core, the seed from which springs the mighty tree of those committed to lifelong learning.

The chain of office worn by the president is made of solid sterling silver. The lapis lazuli gems, mounted on scroll shapes, represent the colleges within the University. The knotted components depict the interdependence of knowledge and the various academic programs of MTSU. The sterling and lapis lazuli represent the University colors of blue and white. The Great Seal of the State of Tennessee embellishes the medallion suspended from the chain, representing the University as part of the Tennessee Board of Regents system.

These unique emblems of authority were designed and crafted by Professor Klaus Kallenberger, formerly of the Art Department. The mace and chain of office are a generous gift to the University from the MTSU Foundation.

University Honors College

Dr. Philip Edward Phillips is professor of English and associate dean of the University Honors College at Middle Tennessee State University. He earned his Ph.D. in English at Vanderbilt University in 1996, and he has worked at MTSU since 1999. Phillips served as chair of the Graduate Council in 2007–08. He teaches courses and directs undergraduate and graduate research in medieval, Renaissance, and 19th-century American literature. His publications include *John Milton's Epic Invocations: Converting the Muse* (Lang, 2000), *New Directions in Boethian Studies* (MIP, 2007), *The Consolation of Queen Elizabeth I* (ACMRS, 2009), *A Companion to Boethius in the Middle Ages* (Brill, 2012), *Prison Narratives from Boethius to Zana* (Palgrave, 2014), and *Vernacular Traditions of Boethius's De consolatione*

philosophiae (MIP, 2016). He has also published work in *Global Perspectives on Medieval Literature and Culture* (MIP, 2007), *Approaches to Teaching Poe's Prose and Poetry* (MLA, 2008), *The Milton Encyclopedia* (Yale, 2012), *Edgar Allan Poe in Context* (Cambridge, 2013), and *Deciphering Poe: Subtexts, Contexts, Subversive Meanings* (Lehigh, 2013), as well as *The Edgar Allan Poe Review* and *Poe Studies*. Works in progress include *Remaking Boethius: The English Translation Tradition of Boethius's De consolatione philosophiae* and *Poe and Place*. For more than 15 years, he served as co-editor of *Carmina Philosophiae: Journal of the International Boethius Society*. He received the MTSU Foundation Distinguished Research Award in both 2007–08 and 2014–15. He also is the recipient of a Mary Catherine Mooney Research Fellowship at the Boston Athenæum, a W.T. Bandy Fellowship at the Center for Baudelaire and Modern French Studies at Vanderbilt University, and two consortium research fellowships at the Newberry Library in Chicago. Phillips is the secretary of the International Boethius Society, the immediate past president of the Poe Studies Association, and a life member of the Milton Society of America. He also is president of the MTSU chapter of Phi Kappa Phi honor society. He founded and directs the Great Books in Middle Tennessee Prisons Program at Riverbend Maximum Security Institution and Lois Deberry Special Needs Facility in partnership with the Great Books Foundation, the Tennessee Department of Correction, and MTSU.

MACE BEARERS

Morning

Dr. Ahad Nasab is a professor and coordinator for the Mechatronics Engineering program at MTSU. He earned M.S. and Ph.D. degrees in Mechanical Engineering from the Georgia Institute of Technology in 1981 and 1987, respectively. He was then employed as a staff scientist at the Center for Laser Applications of the University of Tennessee Space Institute. He joined MTSU in 1991 and teaches courses at all levels in the Mechatronics Engineering program. Nasab is also a Level III Siemens certified instructor in mechatronics and has recently been awarded a National Science Foundation S-STEM grant to attract women and minorities to the field of engineering. Nasab's research and publications range from studies in post-operation tensile strength of finger ligaments to robotics, laser material processing, and space propulsion. He has more than 30 publications in national and international journals.

Afternoon

Dr. Jason Pettigrew is an assistant professor of Spanish in the Department of Foreign Languages and Literatures. He attended Carson-Newman College in Jefferson City, Tennessee, where he majored in English and Spanish. He completed an M.A. in Spanish and a Ph.D. in Modern Foreign Languages at the University of Tennessee. Pettigrew has taught Spanish language courses at all levels, Hispanic American literature, and foreign language teaching methodology. He also serves as the faculty advisor to the MTSU Spanish Club and is a member of the honors faculty. His area of specialization is Hispanic American literature, and his main research interest is the analysis of 20th-century poetry. He has published articles on the poetry of José Pascual Buxó and Carlos Pellicer. He also co-authored an article about implementing the blended learning model in large multi-section foreign language programs. In 2015, Pettigrew was honored to receive one of the MTSU

Outstanding Teacher awards. As an instructor of Spanish, he wants students to realize that knowledge of other cultures and languages can not only help them reach professional goals, but can also enrich their understanding and participation in national and world communities. He strives to maintain an approach to foreign language teaching that is informed by sound research on second language acquisition. He endeavors to keep his classroom learner-centered, open to different learning styles, and low-anxiety, so that students will feel comfortable experimenting with Spanish. Pettigrew also strives to integrate culture into his language classes. He not only wants students to build communicative competence in Spanish, but also to open their minds to the peoples and cultures of our interconnected world. The broadened perspective and cultural understanding that students gain through foreign language study are the ultimate goals of all his efforts in the classroom.

Academic Regalia

The black gowns and colorful hoods traditionally worn in Middle Tennessee State University commencement ceremonies have their origins in the Middle Ages.

A statute in England in 1321 required that all “Doctors, Licentiates, and Bachelors” wear gowns. In the second half of the 14th century, the statutes of certain colleges forbade “excess in apparel” and prescribed the wearing of a long gown. Scholars were often clerics as well, and they adopted costumes similar to those of monastic orders. While the special attire covered rank or social status, thus lending a uniform look to ceremonies, it also served another purpose: warmth in drafty, unheated buildings.

As the universities began to pass from the control of the church, colors often were added to the somber robes and hoods, eventually signifying the degree and specialization.

The cut of the gown, which is usually black, also varies with the degree held—pointed sleeves for the bachelor’s degree; long, closed sleeves with a slit in the arm for the master’s degree; and round, open sleeves for the doctoral degree. While the bachelor’s and master’s gowns have no ornamentation, the doctoral gown is faced down the front with velvet and has three velvet bars across the sleeves.

At Middle Tennessee, hoods are worn by holders of the master’s and doctor’s degrees, with the latter being longer. Hoods are lined with the official colors of the university which confers the degree; thus holders of degrees from MTSU wear hoods lined in blue and white. The velvet edging on the hood, and often the velvet edging on the gown, represents the candidate’s major academic field. Often holders of the Doctor of Philosophy degree (Ph.D.) will be seen with regalia in dark blue instead of a color symbolic of their discipline. This is accepted academic dress. Further, the velvet lining on the gown may be the same color as the discipline color of the hood, or may be black. Colors associated with various subjects follow:

The black cap, the mortarboard, is customarily worn. There is no general rule for the position of the tassel. In practice at Middle Tennessee State University, the tassel is worn on the right. It may be shifted to the left after the degree is awarded. Men may remove their caps during prayer, the playing of the alma mater, and during the commencement address.

Honors graduates are distinguished by the stoles added to their gowns: gold for those graduating summa cum laude, 3.90 to 4.0 (overall grade point average); silver for magna cum laude, 3.75 to 3.89; and white for cum laude, 3.50 to 3.74. Graduates with University Honors wear blue and white cords and have completed at least 31 hours with a 3.25 average in the Honors program, a curriculum of special classes designed for superior students. Those who have maintained a minimum average of 3.65 in the Honors program are graduating with Distinction in University Honors. Honors graduates and persons graduating with University Honors, along with those who have been commissioned second lieutenant in the United States Army, are listed in this program after the degree recipients.

Some academic honor societies and programs may provide cords, ribbons, medallions, or lapel pins designating the achievement and involvement of their members.

Since 1993, graduates of the University Honors College have received the official Honors medallion in recognition of their final thesis defense and completion of special requirements of the college. The medallion itself is a two-dimensional replica of the official seal of the University Honors College and depicts a lighted torch, three Ionic columns, and a lightning bolt. Respectively, these symbolize the search for truth and knowledge, the stability and unwavering commitment to pursuing knowledge, and the flash of enlightenment or creative energy.

Military veteran students are distinguished by red, white, and blue cords in recognition of their admirable service to their country.

Experiential Learning Scholars are distinguished by blue, silver, and white cords. These scholars completed EXL-designated hands-on learning courses, an off-campus service activity, an on-campus service activity, and a portfolio of reflections on their EXL activities. The EXL program provides students with opportunities for hands-on experience, valuable networking, and an opportunity to explore career paths through real-world experience.

International students may wear colorful sashes that are representative of their country of origin. Each sash symbolizes, in color and design, their country's flag.

Most American colleges and universities have adopted a uniform code. However, at any academic gathering, costumes often are worn that are not described by these guidelines. Some of these may be from foreign universities, others from American institutions that have preferred to remain with the European tradition of allowing each school to determine its own costume. Silver medallions worn by faculty denote 15 years of service, and gold medallions represent 25 years.

Academic Banners

College of Graduate Studies

Dr. Scott Handy was appointed interim associate dean of the College of Graduate Studies in 2014 at Middle Tennessee State University. He earned his B.S. in Chemistry from the University of Iowa in 1991 and then completed a Ph.D. in Chemistry from Indiana University in 1996 under the direction of Dr. Paul Grieco in the area of organic synthesis. Following a National Institutes of Health post-doctoral fellowship at Stanford University in the labs of Dr. Paul Wender, Handy began his independent academic career at the State University of New York at Binghamton in 1999. He moved to MTSU in 2005 as

associate professor of Chemistry and was promoted to professor in 2011. He maintains a fascination with the synthesis of biologically active compounds and has a number of active collaborations with other research groups in the application of compounds that his group has prepared.

College of Basic and Applied Sciences

Dr. Ron Henderson is professor and chair of the Department of Physics and Astronomy. He has published in refereed journals and presented at technical conferences on over 35 occasions with studies focused on light emission and detection using silicon, compound semiconductors, and inorganic quantum dots. Henderson has also won more than \$1 million in funding to support these and other research efforts. Most recently, he has concentrated on ways to improve undergraduate physics instruction and on the preparation of future physics teachers. MTSU Physics and Astronomy is now recognized as a national leader in these areas, and was identified as one of only three Departments of Distinction by the American Physical Society in 2015. His education includes degrees from the University of Tennessee (B.S.), Duke (M.S.), and the University of Virginia (Ph.D.).

College of Behavioral and Health Sciences

Dr. Justin Bucchio joined the MTSU Department of Social Work in 2014. He is an alumnus of MTSU's undergraduate Social Work program, and received his master's and doctoral degrees in Social Work from the University of Tennessee. Prior to joining MTSU's faculty, Bucchio trained numerous child welfare professionals in New York City, provided therapy to children and their families with developmental disabilities, and was clinical manager for a residential treatment facility that serves children with autism. He has worked with states' child welfare programs to create and implement policies to better serve and protect the LGBT foster youth population, which is also the primary focus of his research.

Jennings A. Jones College of Business

Dr. Raj Srivastava is an associate professor in the Marketing Department in the Jones College of Business. He has an undergraduate degree in Industrial Engineering from his native country of India. He completed an M.B.A. and a Ph.D. in Marketing from the University of North Texas. He joined MTSU in 2005 after working at Texas Wesleyan University and the University of Louisiana–Lafayette. He teaches several online courses at both undergraduate and graduate levels and also teaches the Marketing Management course. Srivastava has published extensively in journals like *Journal of Business Ethics*, *Journal of Personal Selling and Sales Management*, and *Journal of Business and Industrial Management*. His main areas of research are in sales and in coping with work stress. He has also published in the legal aspects of sales area. Srivastava was awarded the Col. Migiliorino and Lt. Col. Piccione Faculty Award for Research Excellence in the College of Business Administration at University of Louisiana–Lafayette in 2002–03 and Acadiana Bottling Endowed Professorship in Marketing (2004–05). He has been reviewer for several marketing-related journals such as *JPSSM* and *Journal of Marketing Communications* and has also been active in several professional organizations like Society for Marketing Advances and Atlantic Marketing Association. He was track chair for 2013, 2014, and 2015 SMA proceedings and is track chair for the 2016 AMA proceedings.

College of Education

Dr. Robyn Ridgley is an associate professor in the department of Elementary and Special Education in the College of Education. She earned her Doctorate of Education in Early Childhood Special Education from the University of Kentucky. She received a Master of Education degree in Early Childhood Special Education from Vanderbilt University's Peabody College and a

Bachelor of Science degree in Elementary Education and Special Education from Murray State University. Ridgley is a faculty member in the Early Childhood Education undergraduate program and the doctoral program in Assessment, Learning, and School Improvement. She teaches courses that focus on early literacy, assessment, and applied experiences in early childhood and other school settings. She serves as the principal investigator for the MTSU Home and Community-Based Early Intervention Program. For the past two years, Ridgley has actively supported the Ann Campbell Early Learning Center in a variety of roles. She enjoys working with classroom teachers and early intervention professionals as they support children and their families. Her research has focused on improving interactions and supports provided to families of young children receiving early intervention services.

College of Liberal Arts
